

# Transitioning from Year 10 into Year 11

## WHAT CAN PARENTS DO TO SUPPORT?

Revision is vital for all students, but it can lead to a great deal of stress and anxiety. Here are some tips to help you support your child with their revision:

- ◇ Encourage your child to start revision **now**. This will ensure that the information they require is revisited and is likely to be retained for the exam.
- ◇ Prioritise attendance. It is essential that students arrive to school on time and attend every lesson possible in the lead up to their exams.
- ◇ Support your child with attending p.6 interventions in as many subjects as they can.
- ◇ Provide a quiet place for revision and remove distractions such as mobile phones while your child is revising.

## WHAT WILL THE MALLING SCHOOL DO TO SUPPORT?
