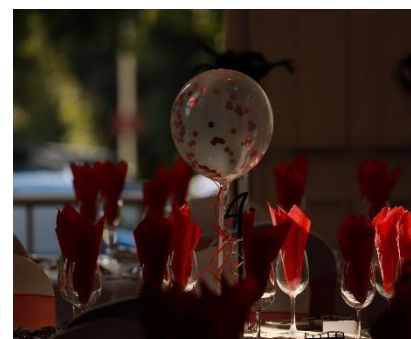
During last week's assembly, Mrs. Cable and Mrs. Whitfield shared exciting details about this year's Prom plans, which include:
